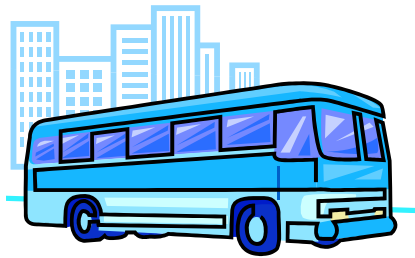
Without giving away too many details, we have some very special things planned for the April and May meetings. Be sure to hear more when you attend the March meeting.
